This Product-Specific Terms document ("Document") contains additional terms and conditions for the Software licensed under the Cohesity Software Terms of Use or other similar agreement agreed to by Cohesity ("License Agreement") between You as the individual, the company, or the legal entity that will be utilizing the Software (referenced below as "You" or "Your") and Cohesity, Inc. Capitalized terms used in this Document but not defined herein will have the meaning given in the License Agreement. To the extent there is a conflict between the terms and conditions of the License Agreement and this Document, the terms and conditions of this Document will take precedence. BY DOWNLOADING, INSTALLING OR USING THE SOFTWARE, YOU AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE PRODUCT USE RIGHTS IN THIS DOCUMENT, IN ADDITION TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LICENSE AGREEMENT. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE PRODUCT USE RIGHTS APPLICABLE TO THE SOFTWARE, DO NOT DOWNLOAD, INSTALL OR USE THE SOFTWARE.

For purposes of this Document, the Software is: NetBackup Appliance Software.

- 1. ADDITIONAL DEFINITIONS.
- **1.1** "Node" means a physical individual computer, acting as a service or resource provider to client computers by sharing the resources within the network infrastructure.
- **1.2 "Tebibyte" or "TiB"** is defined as the total aggregate amount of uncompressed data storage capacity that is managed by the software. One Tebibyte is equal to 2⁴⁰ or 1,099,511,627,776 bytes of data.
- **1.3 "Terabyte" or "TB"** is defined as the total aggregate amount of uncompressed data storage capacity and/or computer memory that is managed by the software. One Terabyte is equal to 10¹² bytes, or 1,000 Gigabytes or 0.90949470177293 Tebibytes of data.

For purposes of defining useable storage capacity, which is calculated based on TiB, note the conversion table above. For example, a license entitlement of 240 equals to actual useable storage capacity of 264 TB.

The Software is licensed using integer values. The calculated number of bytes may yield a value that requires rounding to be performed in order to present an integer number. In such cases, Cohesity will round down to the nearest whole number. For example, when converting from 700TB, this equals to 636.64629TiB, and You are required to purchase 636 units of Software.



- 2. ADDITIONAL USE RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.
- **2.1 General Rights**. You may use the number of licensed Terabytes of the Software per the terms contained in the License Agreement and according to the usage limitations for the licenses which You have purchased in accordance with the terms of this Section.
- **2.2. Term of License; License Use**. The Software is licensed either on a perpetual basis or term subscription basis.
 - **2.2.1.** If the Software is licensed to You on a perpetual basis, the Software must only be used with the specific Node on which the Software is originally pre-loaded or pre-installed and Your license to the Software shall terminate at the end of the life of that specific Node. Use of the Software on additional, different, or subsequent Nodes requires Cohesity authorization, provided in its sole discretion.
 - 2.2.2 If the License Software is licensed to You on a term license or subscription basis, then during the term of the subscription license, Your license is portable between Nodes, provided however, deployment of the Software is only permitted on a successive and not concurrent basis between Nodes. Accordingly, the Software must be uninstalled from, and no longer used on, any Node on which the Software was previously installed before use on a subsequent Node. Use of the Software on any other Nodes requires Cohesity authorization, provided in its sole discretion.
- **3. RESTRICTION**. You may not use the Software, Documentation, or user information accompanying the Software to assist, directly or indirectly, in the development or design of any computer hardware or software program including, but not limited to, a program that provides or is intended to provide or include a similar feature or functionality as the Software, or any conversion utility or aid relating to the Software intended to enable or facilitate a user's conversion from the use of the Software to an alternative program.
