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"Cold Disaster Recovery Equipment" means a server and/or processor or device on which the Licensed Software may be installed and configured under a Cold Disaster Recovery License, and which is not production use servicing transactions or requiring workloads during periods of Your normal internal business operations.

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"Failover Readiness Testing" means testing of the procedures for transferring Your production operation from one server to another.

"Gigabyte" or "GB" is defined as the total aggregate amount of data storage capacity and/or computer memory that is managed by the software. One Gigabyte is equal to 10^9 or 1,000,000,000 bytes of data.

"Node" means a physical individual computer, acting as a service or resource provider to client computers by sharing the resources within the network infrastructure.

"Production Use" means any functional operation of the Licensed Software in support of Your normal business operations (such as normal productive use and pre-production testing other than Failover Readiness Testing).

"Tebibyte" or "TiB" is defined as the total aggregate amount of data storage capacity that is managed by the software. One Tebibyte is equal to 2^{40} or 1,099,511,627,776 bytes of data.

For purposes of defining useable storage capacity, which is calculated based on TiB, note the conversion table above. For example, a license entitlement of 102 equals to actual useable storage capacity of 112 TB.

The Licensed Software is licensed using integer values. The calculated number of bytes may yield a value that requires rounding to be performed in order to present an integer number. In such cases, for Gen 10, Veritas will round up to the nearest whole number, and for Gen 11, Veritas will round down to the nearest whole number. For example, with Gen 10 (14TB), when converting from 112TB, this equals to 101.863TiB, and You are required to purchase 102 units of Licensed Software. For example, with Gen 11 (16TB), when converting from 128TB, this equals to 116.415 TiB, and You are required to purchase 116 units of Licensed Software and with Gen 11 (20TB), when converting from 160TB (20TB), this equals to 145.519 TiB, and You are required to purchase 145 units of Licensed Software.

“Terabyte” or “TB” means the total aggregate amount of data storage capacity and/or computer memory that is managed by the software. One Terabyte is equal to 10^{12} bytes, or 1,000 Gigabytes or 0.90949470177293 Tebibytes of data.

“Testing Day” means a period of twenty-four (24) consecutive hours, or any lesser portion of such twenty-four (24) hour period.

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
