How identity-based attacks put financial services in the crosshairs

Financial services led all industries in breaches in 2025, with compromised credentials being the #1 attack vector. Your identity attack surface continues to expand daily due to:

- **Legacy AD infrastructure:** Active Directory (AD) is a highly prevalent and decades-old identity system where vulnerabilities and misconfigurations have built-up over the years. Coupled with an aging infrastructure, many financial services firms cite inadequate protection and lack of visibility over security gaps affecting their most critical identity and access management systems.
- **Hybrid environment complexity:** Cloud identity systems expand the attack surface, and attackers are now pivoting between on-prem AD and cloud identity systems in hybrid environments. That introduces more blind spots and thus more vulnerabilities that can be exploited.
- **High concentration of attacks:** Attackers see identity as the front door to an organization's network and data. Cohesity's CERT team finds that 95% of security incidents involve AD. This is largely because attackers know that identity underpins enterprise access. Compromising AD means the business is forced into a standstill.

Financial services case study

First Horizon Bank: Stolen Credentials Drain Customer Accounts (April 2021)

Target: First Horizon Bank – \$87.5 billion-asset financial institution based in Memphis, Tennessee.

Attack Vector: Compromised credentials combined with exploitation of third-party security software vulnerability. Attackers obtained login credentials from an unknown source, then leveraged them to access customer accounts.

Business Impact:

- Nearly 200 customer accounts compromised
- Customer funds fraudulently withdrawn from accounts
- Attackers accessed sensitive personal information including SSNs, addresses, account numbers
- Bank forced to reimburse customers, close and reopen all affected accounts
